Dislike of bright light 

 Stiff neck

Confusion and/or irritability 

 Rapid breathing

Vomiting/diarrhoea 

 Seizures/fits

Stomach cramps 

 High temperature

Rash/bruising rash 

 Drowsy or difficult to wake

Pale blotchy skin 

 Cold hands and feet

Joint or muscle pain
